<p>Disciples prepare for the Passover</p> <p>The 14th at even marks the beginning of the Feast of Unleavened Bread; Yahshua partakes of the Passover meal with the disciples and afterward institutes His body and blood through the bread and cup.</p> <p>-----></p>	<p>Yahshua prays in garden and is taken away.</p> <p>Yahshua taken to Ananias ...</p> <p>... is sent bound to Caiaphas ...</p> <p>Peter denies Yahshua</p> <p>-----></p>	<p><---- Yahshua taken to Pilate ... is rejected by Israel and beaten with a whip: ...
